

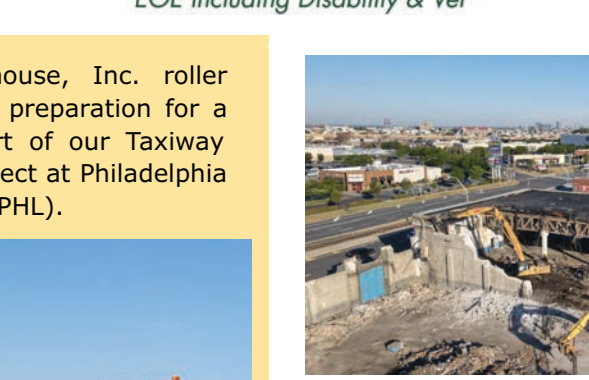

### Remembering John R. "Jack" Kibblehouse

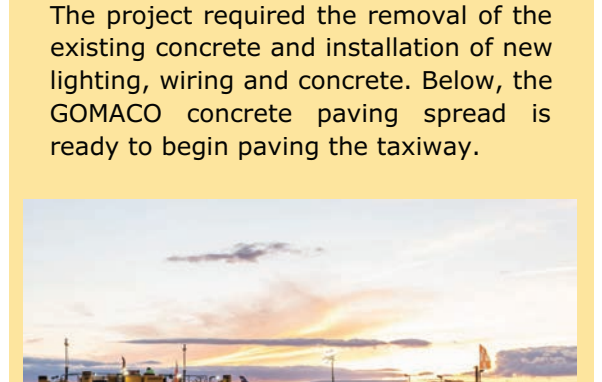

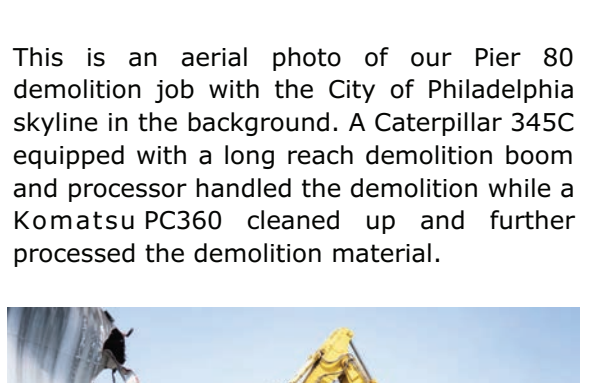
## REGIONAL CONTRACTING SPOTLIGHT



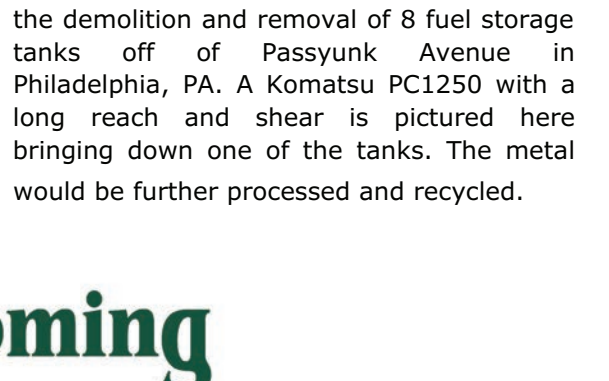

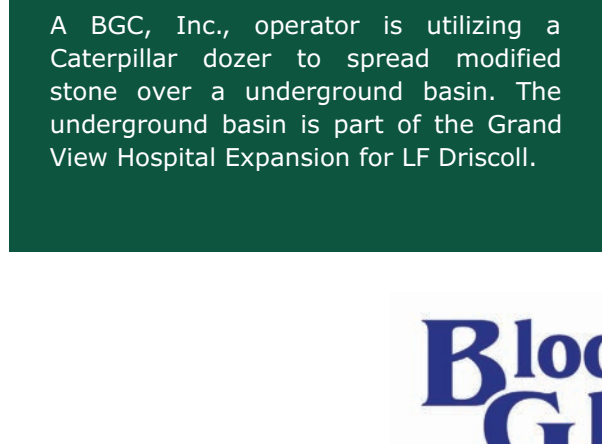

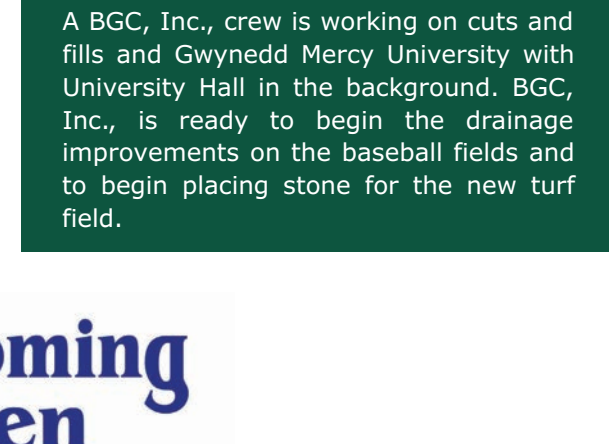

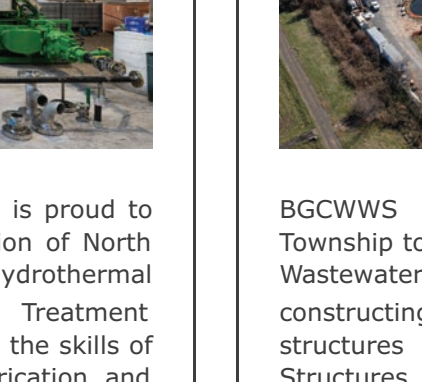
Haines & Kibblehouse, Inc. was tasked with the demolition and removal of 8 fuel storage tanks off of Passyunk Avenue in Philadelphia, PA. A Komatsu PC1250 with a long reach and shear is pictured here bringing down one of the tanks. The metal would be further processed and recycled.

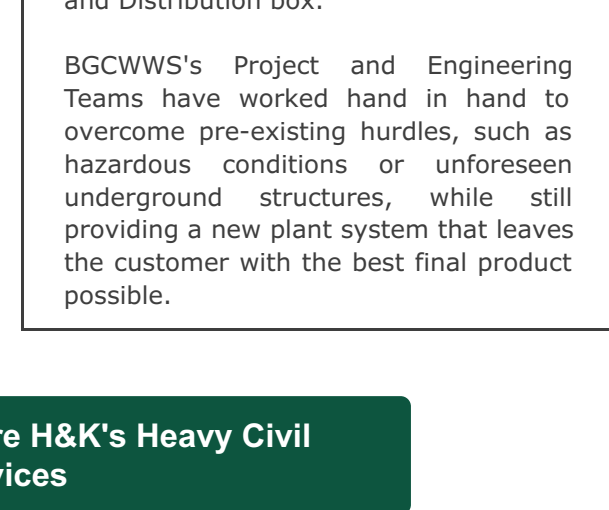

BGCWWS's fabrication team is proud to be part of the implementation of North America's first Hydrothermal Carbonization Wastewater Treatment Plant. This project highlights the skills of both BGCWWS's Metal Fabrication and Mechanical Engineering teams.

BGCWWS's in-house fabrications have used automated and manual welding processes to prefabricate process piping, pipe supports, handrail, staircases, and work platforms for this one-of-a-kind project. The team provided a consistent on-site presence to complete final field fitment and tie-ins through the project's duration.

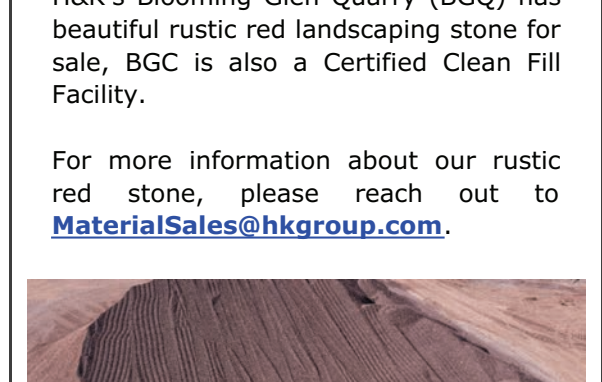


BGCWWS is working with Bristol Township to expand the capacity of their Wastewater Treatment Plant by constructing and tying in four (4) new structures to their existing plant. Structures include a new Chlorine Contact Tank, Clarifier, Pump Station, and Distribution box.

BGCWWS's Project and Engineering Teams have worked hand in hand to overcome pre-existing hurdles, such as hazardous conditions or unforeseen underground structures, while still providing a new plant system that leaves the customer with the best final product possible.

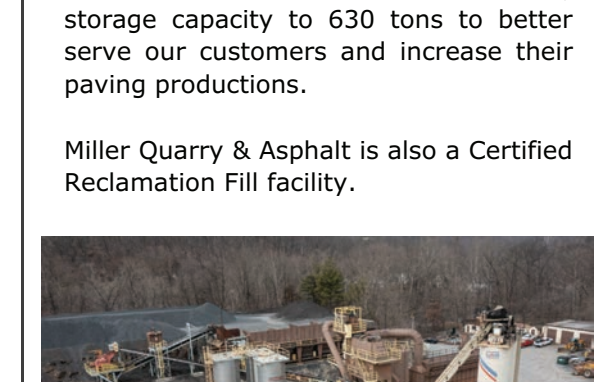

### BLOOMING GLEN QUARRY

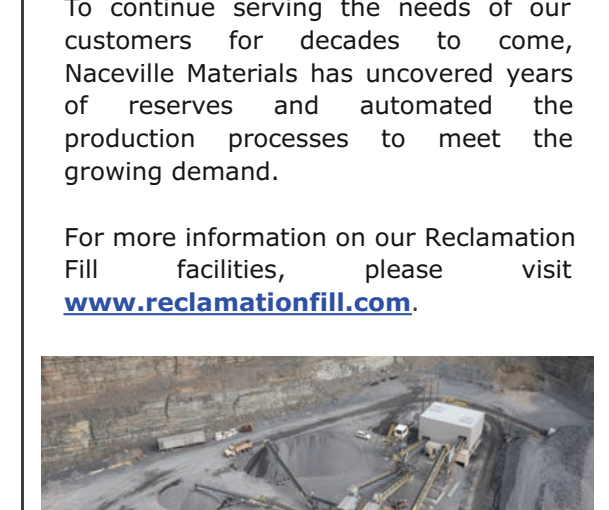
H&K's Blooming Glen Quarry (BGQ) has beautiful rustic red landscaping stone for sale, BGC is also a Certified Clean Fill Facility.

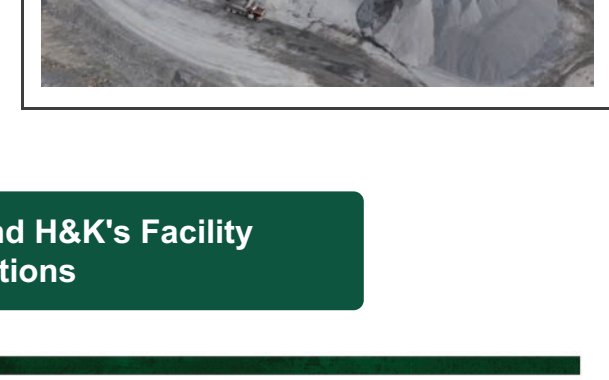
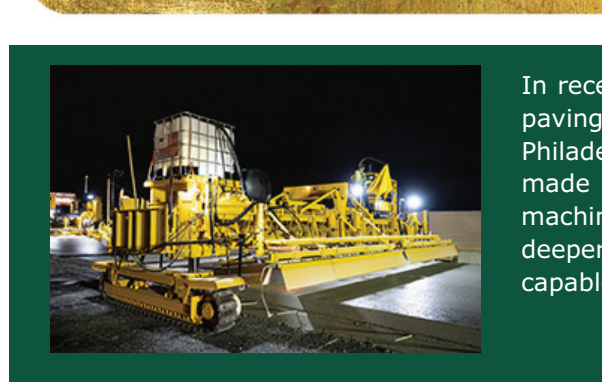
Miller Quarry & Asphalt recently added a third silo to its asphalt plant, increasing storage capacity to 630 tons to better serve our customers and increase their paving productions.

H&K's Pyramid Quarry is strategically located in Delaware County, PA. This Certified Reclamation Fill facility has construction aggregate available to serve the local market.



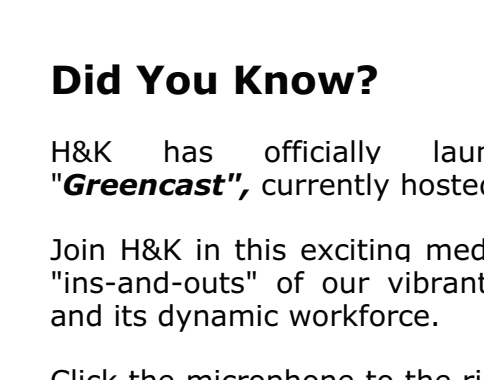
