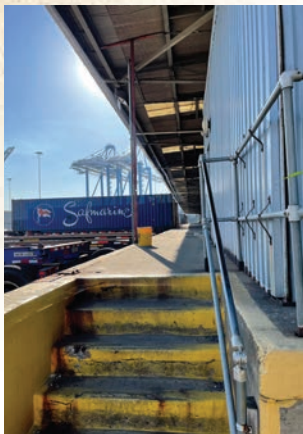

## Project Info

Shed 6 was used as a dry goods warehouse for many years inside the marine terminal. Space was needed to stack more cargo containers, so Haines & Kibblehouse, Inc. (H&K) was tasked with demolishing the 100,000 SF structure. H&K was also awarded the new dry warehouse set to open in June of 2022.

The building was made up of structural steel joists and columns and aluminum siding. A grapple and shears made quick work of the demolition of the building, while a hammer and processor took care of the concrete loading dock and column foundations.

In addition to the building, there was a significant amount of railroad ties and track that had to be hammered out and cut into manageable pieces.
