



EOE Including Disability & Vet In March 2024, Blooming Glen Contractors, Inc., started work on the Delp Drive Warehouse

(E&S) controls, underground utilities, curb, retaining walls, an arch culvert, soundwall, landscaping and paving. Some highlight numbers include 12,500 linear feet of installed pipe, 41,000 square feet of retaining walls installed, 129,000 cubic yards of excavation, 110,000 cubic yards of grading, 10,000 tons of asphalt paved and 34,000 cubic yards of sub-base material placed. 
